

Senior Singles tournament continues through Sunday

With three squads to go in the 7th Annual Senior Singles Championships sponsored by the Greater Calumet USBC, the scores to beat have been established.

Bowlers from Hammond, Highland and Dolton are leading the four divisions based on age and handicap after one squad (Sunday, Jan. 20) at Lan-Oak Lanes in Lansing.

Leading the A Division for bowlers 50-59 who average 201 or more with a 778 is Jim Rutherford of Hammond, who rolled games of 279, 238 and 246 with 15 pins of handicap.

In Class B, for bowlers 50-59 who average 200 or less, Andy Hoke, of Highland, leads the way with a 596.

In Class C, for bowlers 60 and older who average 201 or more, Dolton's Mose Bowling leads the way with a 776.

Hammond bowler Pat Scardina leads Class D, for bowlers 60 and older who average 200 or less, with a 602.

The tournament, which is open to men and women GCA USBC sanctioned bowlers, continues at 2 p.m. Saturday, and 9 a.m. and noon Sunday at Lan-Oak, 2524 Ridge Road, Lansing.

Entries are \$25 and walk-ins are welcome.

In the tournament, bowlers bowl four games and only the top three count.

The GCA USBC represents sanctioned league bowlers at bowling centers in Dyer, Griffith, Highland Hammond and Whiting in Indiana and Calumet City, Lansing and Lynwood in Illinois.
